1 Plaintiff alleges:
2

3 ALLEGATIONS COMMON TO ALL CAUSES OF ACTION
4

5 The Parties

6 1. Plaintiff Virgin Records America, Inc. was at all times herein relevant,
7 and now is, a corporation duly created, organized, and existing under and by virtue
8 of the laws of the State of California. Virgin Records America, Inc. is engaged in
9 the business of producing "phonorecords" as defined in Section 2855(b)(1) of the
10 California Labor Code.

11
12 2. Plaintiff Capitol Records, LLC d/b/a Capitol Music Group ("Capitol" is
13 a limited liability company duly created, organized and existing under the laws of
14 the State of Delaware. Virgin Records America, Inc. and Capitol are collectively
15 referred to herein as "Plaintiff" or "Virgin."
16

17 3. Defendants Jared Leto and Shannon Leto, ("defendants") are recording
18 artists who have recorded phonorecords for Virgin pursuant to a written agreement
19 under the professional name "30 Seconds To Mars." Plaintiff is informed and
20 believe, and on that basis alleges, that defendants are residents of California.
21

22 4. Plaintiff is ignorant of the true names and capacities of defendants sued
23 herein as Does 1 through 10, inclusive. Plaintiff will amend this complaint to allege
24 their true names and capacities when the same have been ascertained. Plaintiff is
25 informed and believes and on that basis alleges that each of the fictitiously named
26 defendants is responsible in some manner for the harm and damages suffered by
27 plaintiff.
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The Recording Agreement

5. On or about October 15, 1999, Immortal Records, LLC ("Immortal"), on the one part, and Jared Leto and Shannon Leto, on the other part, entered into a written recording agreement ("the "1999 Recording Agreement"). Pursuant to the 1999 Recording Agreement, Jared Leto and Shannon Leto agreed to deliver to Immortal master recordings (i.e., phonorecords) satisfactory for the manufacture and sale of phonograph records embodying the performances of defendants under the name "30 Seconds To Mars" ("30STM"). During the initial term of the 1999 Recording Agreement, Jared Leto and Shannon Leto were obligated to deliver master recordings sufficient to manufacture and sell one long-playing phonograph record album ("Album") embodying the performances of 30STM, in accordance with a schedule specified therein. The 1999 Recording Agreement further granted Immortal four separate automatically exercised options to acquire up to an additional four Albums embodying the performances of 30STM. Immortal agreed in return, inter alia, to pay certain sums to defendants and a royalty based on sales of the Albums embodying the performances of 30STM.

6. Effective May 2004, Virgin acquired all of Immortal's rights, obligations, and interest in the Albums and under the 1999 Recording Agreement.

7. Defendants delivered the Album required to be delivered during the initial term of the 1999 Recording Agreement. Plaintiff thereafter duly exercised the first and second options under the 1999 Recording Agreement.

8. Defendants have delivered a total of only two Albums embodying the performances of 30STM. There remain due and undelivered three Albums

1 embodying the performances of defendants (one additional in the second option
2 period, one in the third option period, and one in the fourth option period).

3
4 9. To the extent their notice was valid, defendants repudiated the 1999
5 Recording Agreement in writing and their obligations to deliver to plaintiff
6 recordings thereunder and claimed that they were excused from such performance
7 from and after July 4, 2008, pursuant to California Labor Code § 2855(a). The
8 purported July 4, 2008 termination was addressed and sent to "Capitol Music
9 Group," and it is for that reason that Capitol joins as Plaintiff in this action.

10 Defendants did not claim that plaintiff had in any way failed to perform its
11 obligations under the 1999 Recording Agreement or that the 1999 Recording
12 Agreement for any other reason was subject to termination. Defendants have failed
13 and refused to perform under the 1999 Recording Agreement or to deliver any of the
14 remaining three Albums required to be delivered thereunder.

15
16 **FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION**

17 **(For Breach of the 1999 Written Recording Agreement,**
18 **Against All Defendants)**

19
20 10. Virgin incorporates herein by reference each and every allegation
21 contained in paragraphs 1 through 9, inclusive.

22
23 11. Virgin has performed each and every term, covenant, and condition on
24 its part to be performed pursuant to the 1999 Recording Agreement except as
25 excused or rendered impossible by the acts and conduct of defendants.

1 Agreement, Virgin is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that it has been
2 damaged in an amount in excess of 30 million dollars (\$30,000,000), including lost
3 receipts and profits from the three undelivered Albums (phonorecords).

4
5 **WHEREFORE**, plaintiff prays for judgment against defendants, and each of
6 them, jointly and severally, as follows:

7
8 1. As to the first cause of action for damages for breach of the 1999
9 Recording Agreement, including lost receipts and profits, in excess of \$30,000,000.

10
11 2. As to the second cause of action, for damages pursuant to Labor Code
12 §2855, for failure to deliver all phonorecords required to be delivered under the
13 1999 Recording Agreement, including lost receipts and profits, in excess of
14 \$30,000,000.

15
16 3. As to all causes of action:
17 (a) For interest according to law;
18 (b) For costs of suit incurred herein; and
19 (c) For such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and
20 proper under the circumstances.
